Discussions about the event also revealed that moving the Christmas Lights switch-on from Friday evening to Saturday evening had worked well with a huge turnout for the Civic Parade (see photos above) despite relatively poor weather conditions.

Fiona and Hannah have asked that all traders that participated be thanked for your efforts and for making the overall event a success. They were also delighted to confirm that over £350 had been raised from a raffle and has now been donated to the Newport Cottage Care Centre to help with their fantastic work.

## Heritage Lottery Fund Bid for Newport........

The Town Team Manager, assisted by Katie Foster (advisor) and local public and voluntary sector organisations, has now made a bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund under their 'Our Heritage' programme.

These proposals complement two earlier bids made to Telford & Wrekin Council under their 'Pride in Your High Street' initiative. The HLF bid aims to bring Newport's rich heritage to life, engaging all sectors of our community, attracting more visitors, and helping to evolve Newport's evening / weekend economy.

The bid is made up of a number of discrete but inter-related projects:-

- ❖ Launch event / conference sharing learning & experience
- Visualising Newport through digital technologies
- Newport's 'History Wall' information story boards
- Shutter Stories brightening shop frontages / bringing heritage alive
- Town Maps navigational information points
- Town Heritage Trails
- Heritage Champions training & development of volunteers
- Commemorative Blue Plaques
- Sign of The Times additional signage linking heritage features

Initial bid proposals have been accepted by the HLF and a HLF Project Manager has been allocated to help finalise a few details of our bid proposals. An announcement on the success of this bid is anticipated towards end February or early in March 2016.

## High Street Health-check 2015.....

It's that time of year again with the town team manager busily collating information for the annual high street health-check. This involves collecting a wide-range of data so that we can monitor how well our high street is doing compared to previous years, also compared to similar towns. Having carried out comprehensive surveys in 2013 and 2014 we have decided to carry out a partial survey for 2015 (i.e. no trader, shopper or postcode surveys) however we will be looking at all other data sets with a report due in January 2016.
